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Code of Conduct Agreement Form

by the Maryland Department of Human Resource and Baltimore City Department of Social Services on August 15, 2014. In an effort to ensure that this event is both enjoyable and safe for all that attend, below is a list of expectations that I agree to follow:

1. I will be expected to wear a lanyard with identifying information. Identifying information will include my name and jurisdiction.
2. If accompanied by a chaperone, I will notify him/her of my whereabouts at all times.
3. I will respond to the guidance or instruction of ANY staff in a respectful manner.
4. There is a zero tolerance for drug/alcohol use, possession of any weapons, violence or threats of violence, and/or vandalism to any property at the venue/park. Staff and / or law enforcement will be notified if necessary.
5. All attendees are expected to participate in events and conference activities.
6. All attendees must respect all staff, young adult participants, and individuals present at the venue/park.
7. All trash and waste must be thrown away in proper waste bans or trash cans.

I understand that failure to follow the expectations above may result in my immediate removal from the Older Youth Summit and that any unlawful behavior may be handled by law enforcement.
